## Career Readiness and Classroom Connection Program

***Experience first-hand the skills and expectations Logan County employers have for their workforce so you can share them with your students!***

Teachers ***currently employed*** by an area school are invited to be part of the ***Logan County Education-Industry Partnership's College Readiness Skills Program***. Organized by the Midwest Regional Educational Service Center, Chamber of Commerce, and area employers, the Program is designed to introduce teachers to the current needs and skill demands that employers in Logan County have for the careers that may interest our students. ***This opportunity will allow educators to gain first-hand knowledge of the workforce and 21st century skills that Logan County businesses require for their employees. The knowledge educators gain through this experience can be very valuable as they plan instructional activities and communicate this information to students in their classrooms.***

Individuals successfully completing a week-long internship will receive forty (40) contact hours from the ESC. In lieu of contact hours, participants may also purchase a maximum of two (2) semester hours of graduate credit through Ashland University for an additional fee of \$195 per credit hour.

**What is the commitment?** Teachers chosen to participate in the program will be able to work with participating businesses to schedule an immersive week experience between June 15 and August 5. Participating educators will complete their week experience at a participating employer, attend relevant meetings (if applicable), and provide an overview of their experience at a debriefing session. Teachers will be expected to be onsite at their internship site from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm each day for their scheduled week. *The debriefing luncheon will occur from 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm on August 10, 2017.*

**What Should I Expect?** Teachers will be paired with employers that best match the subject they teach and the priorities listed on their application, so the experience will provide exposure to the most relevant skills and positions for the educator's teaching assignment. The employer will be given your priorities and teaching assignment prior to your week experience. The employer will tailor your week long exposure to allow you to be engaged in experiences that will provide you with the best opportunities to gain important insights and knowledge of necessary skills that you can share with your students concerning career readiness.



**Applications must be received no later than May 19, 2017.**
