Logan County (from Prosecutor's Office):

Please report any person purporting to offer "demolition at public expense" or conducting demolitions without a property owner's authorization to local law enforcement.

Demolition permits are REQUIRED to ensure against further damage to public utility infrastructure. Failure to do so may result in civil or criminal liability for the property owner and/or contractor, and delays in rebuilding.

Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Information from Health Department & Solid Waste District:

- 1. If you take storm-related debris to the licensed solid waste facility (landfill) it will be at your cost.
- 2. DO NOT BURN any storm-related debris.
- 3. There is a current Lakeview OEPA approved site for storm-related debris. This is at 320 Lake Street, the ballpark where the old school was located. Please do not mix green, woody, and demolition debris. These should be in separate piles. **This site will close on 05-31-2024.**
- 4. Properties affected by the tornado can place storm-related debris at the curb for pick up.

Logan Soil & Water Conservation District has advised, if in the floodplain there is a report that will have to be provided to your insurance for future coverage after a natural disaster. Repairs or rebuilding in the floodplain may require extra engineering, permits, etc. to be safe and avoid further disasters (due to flooding) or fines and penalties dealing with regulations and insurance companies and mortgage lenders.
